Farmers are given income generation opportunities through the provision of training, equipment and assistance in agriculture and animal husbandry.

Local people are given access to micro credit to set up small businesses such as brick making, furniture making or roadside kiosks.

A number of health initiatives are supported to assist the community including two health clinics, a village health program and a full time nurse to implement preventative health care.



A few goats, fishing or agricultural equipment can be all it takes to help a family step out of the cycle of poverty.
