



# Congregational Christian Church of Niue

## History:

Christianity was brought to Niue in 1846 by a Niuean missionary who received training in Samoa. This work was consolidated by Samoan pastors and missionaries from the London Missionary Society (LMS). The church became autonomous and took the name Ekalesia Niue in 1970, and is officially recognized as the Ekalesia Kerisiano Niue

## Activities:

Emigration is one of the main problems the church is facing. It is related to questions of unemployment, low standards of education and the economic situation of Niue. The Christian education section of the church provides Bible lessons to the only two government schools. The training of the laity, and ministry to the youth, Boys' and Girls' Brigades are among the main activities of the church. The women's fellowship plays an active role in the church.



The Congregational Christian Church of Niue currently has over 1,000 members.
