



# Presbyterian Church of India

## History:

The Presbyterian Church of India was founded in 1841 as a result of the missionary labor of the Presbyterian Church of Wales. The Welsh Church began its missionary work in the Khasi Jaintia Hills area in 1841. In 1926, the highest Church body called "the Synod" of the Presbyterian Church was constituted. In 1953 the Synod was renamed the Assembly, and again in 2002 the Assembly was renamed the "General Assembly of the PCI."

## Activities:

- Creating self-support schemes through multipurpose building projects.
- Providing rescue homes for women
- Training and sending Missionaries within India and abroad.
- Endowment funds to support children to pursue their studies.
- Hospitals and Health Centers.
- Managing Schools and Colleges.
- Empowering Women and Youth in the Church Ministry.
- Organizing seminars on Theological and Social issues.
